John E. Moore, Sr., a World War II veteran and former chief of civilian personnel at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, has given more than 40 years of volunteer leadership to Montgomery County's corporate, non-profit, local government, faith-based and grassroots organizations. He says he focuses on the "Three Fs" of community volunteering: Focus on what you want to do, Function, and Finish. Clearly he is a master of all three stages, and many local and regional groups have taken advantage of his expertise and devotion to working for his community.
